## **Enrolment Procedure a. y. 2019-2020**

2019-2020 enrolment procedure for international students is open. Students holding a qualification issued by a non-Italian University or non-Italian High School and aiming to study at the University of Turin can start the enrolment procedure.

The Letter of enrolment eligibility drawn up according to the form provided by MIUR is mandatory for international students to enrol.

Enrolment procedure is available online on the platform called “Apply@UniTo” (<https://apply.unito.it/>), starting **from 2019 January 14<sup>th</sup> until 2019 April 14<sup>th</sup>**.

International students can apply for up to two degree programmes.

Enrolment procedure **Apply@Unito is mandatory** for students having a qualification issued by a non-Italian University or non-Italian High School and aiming to enrol in a first cycle degree, second cycle degree or one long cycle degree.

Suitable applicants will receive a Letter of enrolment eligibility from the University of Turin. In order to pre-enrol, applicants should present the Letter of enrolment eligibility (drawn up according to the form provided by MIUR) to the competent Embassy or Consulate.

Students who have not been granted the Letter of enrolment eligibility cannot enrol in the University of Turin degree courses.

## **Scholarships for international students a.y. 2019-2020**
